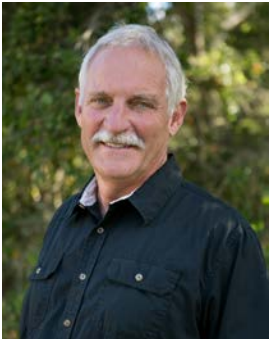

Generations of Healing

A Father & Son Dedicated to Quality Care

Yosef Diab, MD, has very fond memories of going to the hospital as a kid.

That's because—rather than going to the Emergency Room with a broken arm or childhood illness—Yosef got to watch his father in action during Take Your Child to Work Day.

“I've been involved in healthcare from a young age. I loved getting to go to the hospital and the pharmacy,” Yosef said. “I was always encouraged to volunteer through blood drives and raffles.”

His father, Mohammed Diab, RPh, recently retired as head pharmacist at Marian Regional Medical Center after 40 years at

the pharmacy.

A native of Egypt, Mohammed earned a degree in pharmacology from Cairo University before immigrating to the United States in 1982. Once stateside, he earned a doctorate in pharmacology from

Ohio Northern University and got licensed as a pharmacist. He worked at a pharmacy in Maryland before moving to California. He and his wife, Dena, quickly fell in love with the Central Coast and decided to raise their family here.

Years later, Mohammed's passion for medicine and caring for his

community inspired Yosef and his siblings to pursue medical careers as well.

Yosef is a hospitalist at Marian and Arroyo Grande Community Hospital, walking the very same halls as his father. His younger brother, Omar, is a medical student at St. George University in New York City, and his sister, Dina, is a podiatrist in West Palm Beach, Florida.

“Growing up seeing how my dad interacts with people and how people are just naturally attracted to him because he's a good energy type of person, that was something that rubbed off on me,” Yosef said, adding that internal medicine is a natural fit for him because of the doctor-patient relationship.

And Yosef chose to come back to the Central Coast to practice medicine because he loves how tight-knit the community is, especially in Arroyo Grande.

“Our hospital is very community based; it's about healing our community,” Yosef said. “Arroyo Grande has grown, but even as it's gotten bigger, you still have that hominess and that togetherness in the community. We're very fortunate to have such an excellent hospital right here in our town.”

The Emergency Department at Arroyo Grande Community Hospital

Generous Donors Help Meet Growing Needs

The Emergency Department at Arroyo Grande Community Hospital is one of the busiest in San Luis Obispo County. Its central location makes it the best place to come from all over for trusted emergency care. The hospital's name starts with Arroyo Grande, but it serves all of the Five Cities and other nearby communities.

In early 2020, the department underwent an expansion to ensure that everyone who steps through the Emergency Department's (ED) doors continues receiving the highest quality care—thanks in large part to the Legacy Campaign.

“We completed construction on the expansion of the emergency department a month before COVID happened,” said Medical Director Margaux Snider, MD.

“We were seeing about 55 to 70 patients a day at most, all in curtained rooms and about 10 beds. We were still seeing a lot of the community, but the department had already outgrown its previous rooms and there was very little privacy.”

Now, thanks to the expansion, Dr. Snider and her staff are able to see 90 to 100 people a day.

“It’s so nice to have that extra space, and it came at exactly the right time,” she said.

With funds from the Legacy Campaign, the ED footprint was doubled to include 18 beds in private rooms, two triage spaces, and a couple of flexible use spaces, which can be used for a variety of purposes depending on the needs of patients and the hospital.

Other features of the remodel include an updated lobby and intake area and new state-of-the-art equipment, including an

ultrasound machine, an airway purification system, a negative pressure room for controlling infectious diseases, and a psychiatric room for people in crisis.

Funds from the Hoelle Tompkins Sisterhood Society, the Carrol Pruett Philanthropic Fraternity, and other generous donors were also used to pay for a mental health evaluator to better evaluate patients as they come in for care and get them connected with services more quickly. That position was transformative for the department, especially during a time when mental health needs skyrocketed.

It has since shifted to a substance use navigator to address drug and alcohol use in our community and educate patients about treatment options. Like the Emergency Department, its staff members are constantly adapting to best meet the needs of our community.

“This generous community has directly impacted our ability to practice medicine and take care of the community. I’m tremendously grateful to our donors,” Dr. Snider said. “Everything they donate goes directly to the community through tangible changes and improvements.”

Navigating Cancer Care

Navigating a cancer diagnosis and everything that comes with it is an incredibly challenging experience. That's why Mission Hope Cancer Center - Arroyo Grande has people like Oncology Nurse Navigator Lindsey Hughes.

"Usually, I meet people on the worst day of their life," Lindsey said. "My job is to take that really hard diagnosis and create a plan where they feel supported, are educated about what's available to them, and are better able to make decisions for themselves."

Lindsey made a lasting impression on cancer survivor Connie Glenn-Wemple. "From the first days of my treatment she was

always available for questions or lending an ear. She spent the time needed to answer any questions or concerns I or my family had with a smile on her face - never in a hurry. She would take time to check on me in the infusion room, as I am sure she did many other women!" Connie has continued her relationship with Lindsey following her treatment and is honored to call her a friend.

Without donors like you, Lindsey's position wouldn't exist. Nurse navigators are a completely free resource available to the community, which is made possible by the Cancer Care Fund.

in donations to the Cancer Care Fund. 100% of that money stays local and helps to support Lindsey and the other members of her team, including an oncology social worker, a dietician, a rehabilitation trainer, and a transportation coordinator.

In addition to staff, the fund also supports other critical resources for patients and their families, including support groups, counseling sessions, screenings, transportation, gas cards, and more.

"We support the cancer patient and their whole family. Often people don't know how to plug into these kinds of resources because they don't know they're available." Lindsey said.

"We have such a generous community. We're very lucky to live here," Lindsey said. "With the Cancer Care Fund, we're able to have the additional resources needed to help people not only get through their treatment but thrive through their treatment."

This cutting-edge device provides high-quality images and is quieter and reduces the radiation dose to patients, increasing both patient comfort and safety.

The new machine will allow hospital staff to perform imaging procedures directly in the patient's room, minimizing patient movement and discomfort. This increased efficiency will enable the hospital's staff to deliver quicker diagnoses and improved patient care.
